Tasting Notes

Deep red in color, with lifted aromas of black cherry, violet and toffee, this is a full-bodied red with well-integrated, nutty tannins complementing flavors of boysenberry, caramel and subtle black pepper, which lead to a captivating long finish of plum, smoked meats and cola.

Ready to drink but worthy of aging, we recommend pairing this compelling wine with grilled beef steak, mushroom risotto or a traditional full Sunday roast.
